## 1938 Ford Fire Engine No. 1

### Request to Appear at Civic Event Request Form

The Edmonds Fire Department welcomes the opportunity for the community to view a piece of Edmonds' firefighting history at local civic events. Fire Engine No. 1 was reacquired through the fundraising efforts of the [Edmonds Fire Safety Foundation](#). The Engine is available for display at Edmonds civic events under the conditions listed below.



### Conditions

1. The event is located in Edmonds.
2. Civic event sponsors ensure that the display area is supervised, secure, and driving-accessible for a vehicle of this vintage.
3. Fire Department employees or Edmonds Fire Safety Foundation members drive Fire Engine No. 1 to and from the event. Approval of the request depends on driver availability to deliver and pick-up the Engine.
4. Fire Engine No. 1 is a unique piece of Edmonds history owned by Edmonds citizens. While on display, the sponsoring civic organization ensures that the Engine and its history are treated with care and respect.
5. The Fire Department may establish other conditions depending on the weather and the event's location and duration.
